Description:

The client will be provided with a detailed report on the candidates knowledge and ability to perform bridge and cargo watchkeeping duties on a petroleum tanker.

Course Outline:

- Colregs and Buoyage test.
- Communications test.
- Radar and nav aids test.
- Petroleum tanker operations test.
- Coastal navigation and chartwork practical test.
- Knowledge of charts and publications.
- Tide calculations for standard and secondary ports.
- Obtain tidal stream information.
- Plan a passage.
- Compass error calculation.
- Calculate time of sunrise and sunset.
- Simulator exercise.
- Candidate will be required to navigate in the Dover strait for 1 hour performing the normal duties of a watchkeeping officer.
- Oral assessment.
This will be a detailed oral examination based on all of the above topics.

Entry Standards:

Licensed deck officer

Minimum number of participants is one (1) and maximum is eight (8).

Certification:

A detailed evaluation report shall be submitted to the client along with recommendations.
