General Tanker Familiarization (STCW) Course

Description:

The course syllabus covers the mandatory minimum requirements prescribed in Regulation V/1 para 1.2, and Section A-V/1 para 2-7 of STCW '95.

Objectives:

Trainees who successfully complete this course shall enable trainees to serve on oil, chemical and liquified gas tankers in a capacity other than master, chief engineer officer, chief mate or second engineer officer, and to perform specific duties and responsibilities related to cargo or cargo equipment, provided that they are not immediately responsible for the loading, discharging, care in transit or handling of cargo.

Entry Standards:

This course is open to seafarers who intend to serve on board tankers as part of the regular complement. They shall have completed an approved shore based tanker fire fighting course.

Minimum number of participants is six (6) and maximum is twenty-four (24).

Certification:

A certificate of successful completion shall be issued to those participants who successfully complete the course and meet the assessment criteria.
