Specialized Training for Oil Tankers (STCW)

Description:

The course syllabus covers the mandatory minimum requirements prescribed in Regulation V/1 para 2.2, and Section A-V/1 para 9-14 of STCW '95.

Objectives:

Trainees who successfully complete this course shall enable masters, chief engineer officers, chief mates or second engineer officers, or any other appropriately qualified person having immediate responsibility for loading, discharging and care in transit or handling of cargo, to serve on board an oil tanker.

Entry Standards:

This course is open to seafarers who have relevant experience appropriate to their duties on oil tankers. They shall have completed an approved shore based tanker fire fighting course.

Minimum number of participants is six (6) and maximum is twenty-four (24).

Certification:

A certificate of successful completion shall be issued to those participants who successfully complete the course and meet the assessment criteria.
